



## **Drainage Scheme - Sullatober Water, Carrickfergus**

### **Upgrading and Extending Existing Culvert**

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development hereby gives notice in pursuance of Article 12 of the Drainage (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 (as amended) by the Drainage (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001 that it proposes to carry out a drainage scheme on the Sullatober Water, Carrickfergus.

The proposed scheme will involve the replacement of an existing but defective culvert together with extending it to help provide a outlet for upstream drainage from existing and proposed development.

Having determined that the proposed works are not, by reason amongst other things of their nature, size or location, likely to have significant environmental effects it is the Department's intention not to prepare an Environmental Statement.

The scheme proposals may be inspected free of charge by any person during the period Monday 8 December 2008 to Friday 9 January 2009 inclusive at the following locations between the hours 10am to 4pm Monday to Friday.
